

Investing for Success

Under this agreement for 2019
Collinsville State High School will receive

\$71,840

This funding will be used to

- 100% of students achieving above National Minimum Standards (NMS) in Years 7 and 9 for Writing.
- 30% of students achieving in the Upper 2 Bands (U2B) in Years 7 and 9 for Writing.
- 520 MSS in Year 7 for Writing.
- 540 MSS in Year 9 for Writing.
- 90% of students achieving a A-C result in English, Maths, Science and Humanities in Years 7 to 10.
- 50% of students achieving a A-B result English, Maths, Science and Humanities in Years 7 to 10.
- 100% of eligible students achieving a Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE) in Year 12.
- 100% of eligible students achieving an Overall Position (OP) of 1 to 15 in Year 12.

Our initiatives include

- Developing a whole school approach to the teaching and learning of writing using the self-regulated writing model.
- Improving teacher capacity to implement writing in the curriculum, using the Literacy Continuum, through targeted professional development and instructional coaching.
- Improving student outcomes in writing through targeted teaching and learning, and identifying the writing demands across the curriculum.
- Improving student outcomes in reading through targeted intervention.
- Improving student literacy outcomes through additional support in core curriculum classes.
- Implementing short and long-term data cycles to analyse student progress and inform teaching and learning.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Investing in targeted professional development to build Principal, Head of Department (HOD), teacher and teacher aide capacity in the leading, teaching and learning of writing. ~ \$8 000
- Purchasing additional teacher aide time in order to support the teaching and learning of writing in core curriculum classes. ~ \$20 000
- Investing in Inspire, Model, Practise, Apply, Connect, Transform (IMPACT) programs to support students in achieving U2B in writing. ~ \$ 8 840
- Purchasing additional teacher time to create Head of Department (HOD) Curriculum position. ~\$10 000
- Purchasing additional teacher aide time to support QCE outcomes and the completion of traineeships. ~\$25 000
