This funding will be used to

- Build Effective Teaching and Learning practices to increase student engagement and achievement across the curriculum.
- Build the capabilities of staff and students in effective writing across the curriculum.
- Increase the attendance rates for all students from 83.5% to 90% resulting in improved academic outcomes.
- Decrease the percentage of students attending less than 85% from 48% to 20%.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving an A-C result in English, Maths, Science and Humanities in Years 7 to 10 from 74% to 90%.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving an A-B result in English, Maths, Science and Humanities in Years 7 to 10 from 40% to 50%.
- Improve Queensland Certificate of Education or Queensland Certificate of Individual Achievement attainment from 86% to 100%.

Our initiatives include

- Building teacher capacity to implement Effective Teaching and Learning practices across all curriculum areas through coaching, feedback and moderation processes.
- Releasing teachers to participate in moderation processes within our cluster/region for the Senior Curriculum and Year 6 to 7 transition.
- Improving student academic outcomes through additional teacher aide support in core curriculum areas.
- Implementing an Inquiry cycle to increase the capabilities of staff to teach effective writing and students to produce effective writing across all curriculum areas, with a focus on Year 7 & 8 English.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Investing in targeted professional development to build teacher capability in effective writing and moderation processes.
